



Centennial Hop Pellets Type 90

Origin:	Selected from a cross between a Brewer's Gold and a fuggle seedling and a selected USDA male with largely Brewer's Gold parentage.
Maturity:	Mid-season
Yield:	1700 - 2000 kgs/ha (1500-1750 lbs/acre)
Disease Reaction:	No visible reaction to infections with Prunus necrotic ring-spot virus. Moderately resistant to downy mildew and verticillium wilt.
Cone Structure:	Medium sized, dense, compact.
