



## Fuggles Hop Pellets Type 90

<b>Origin:</b>	First propagated in the 1860's from a plant found growing naturally in Kent, England
<b>Maturity:</b>	Early mid season
<b>Yield:</b>	1400 kgs/ha (1235 lbs/acre)
<b>Disease Reaction:</b>	Very sensitive to wilt; susceptible to powdery mildew but shows some resistance to downy mildew
<b>Cone Structure:</b>	Tight medium sized cones

<b>Aroma</b>	Excellent aroma very typical of traditional British ales
<b>Storage Stability</b>	Good

<b>Brewing Character:</b>	The most revered and famous of all English hops. It produces a robust, full and rounded flavor, practically popular in ales. It is often used for dry hopping in cask ales.
