



## Tettnanger Hop Pellets Type 90

<b>Origin:</b>	A landrace variety originating in Germany
<b>Maturity:</b>	Medium early
<b>Yield:</b>	1150 - 1400kgs/ha (1014 - 1235 lbs/acre)
<b>Disease Reaction:</b>	Good resistance to wilt; average resistance to peronospora and powdery mildew
<b>Cone Structure:</b>	Medium size, oval

<b>Aroma</b>	Mild, pleasant, slightly spicy
<b>Storage Stability</b>	Good
